Dear Mahsa,

The last month has been the most stressful dating experience of my life. There were great times, but those are outweighed by the stress and instability of this roller coaster.

I am unable to continue in this relationship due to your erratic and unreliable behavior, your unstable and extreme emotions/personality, and your legal problems. These issues have been recurring themes in our arguments, which have been frequent. I shared my concerns with you again last night in our angry exchange of snaps and texts. After you called me "a fucking moron" (among other things) and said you don't want to be with me or have a family with me, I told you the relationship is over. It was clear that the feeling to end this was mutual. But then in our phone conversation around 2:45 a.m., you told me that you are pregnant, and that you want to reconcile because we make each other happy.

First, if you are actually pregnant, then I don't believe that this pregnancy is from me and you. You used Plan B twice inside of a week with me, and those couple of occasions were the only times we were reckless. We then broke up for a week. Then you told me on May 7, 2021 that you had your period (you told me last night that you were only "spotting" at that time). Since then, the chances of you becoming pregnant are low because we've been more careful and I have barely finished at all when we've had sex. I simply don't believe that I got you pregnant.

In addition to using Plan B, we agreed that if you were or became pregnant before marriage, you would end the pregnancy via RU-486. It was in a conversation on our second or third date that you said "what if I am already pregnant?" At that time, you said you had no idea when your last period was, which is very unusual. So I told you one of my deal-breakers: I will certainly not continue a relationship where the woman is already pregnant from someone else. ****I meant what I said!**** This is why I will require a paternity test in the event you refuse to end this pregnancy. A non-invasive test can be done as early as nine weeks in, which is within the RU-486 window. Paternity tests are required in parentage cases and are conducted by the state, not private facilities, so be ready for that if you take it in that direction. But you have no reason to continue the pregnancy when you have said you don't want to be with me and don't want kids with me.

Separately, I am not okay with your legal problems or your approach to regaining your daughter. I've told you my view on your daughter's case, which is that you need to challenge the parental rights judgment in Texas directly and not file all these cases in California that have nothing to do with your parental rights. I also am not going to help you harass or stalk the foster parents, or tolerate your making false police reports against them (or anyone else). At the rate things are going, eventually you are going to do something illegal and get yourself thrown back in jail, and that is not okay. You also have outstanding warrants, which is a problem because I can't have a situation where my partner is going to be randomly arrested. I am also not going to be with someone who refuses to follow the law or properly resolve her legal issues, even if she makes me happy.

I'm fine with hearing occasionally from you about how you are doing or how things worked out, but I'm sorry to inform you that the relationship is over and I won't be seeing you again that way. I also won't be moving in with you, so I suggest you and Sophia get the place you were thinking of getting.

Sorry it didn't work out. Have a good trip to L.A. and I wish you the best. Please let me know how things turn out for you.
